Teams

Statement of Work

- The SoW for a research project can be a little different from that of other project types. It should include:
 - What do you hope to do?
 - Why do you want to do this?
 - What is new about it?
 - What is the potential impact?
- This SoW will look in many ways like a “proposal”

SoW Components

- More specifically, your SoW should contain:
 - Preliminary critical review of previous related work
 - Specific project goals
 - Plan of attack
 - References
 - List of deliverables
 - Schedule of milestones
 - Budget (including time and other non-\$ resources)
 - Challenges / risks
 - Plan B, maybe C, maybe D...

Preliminary Lit Review

- Note: preliminary *critical* review of related work
 - Last week, we discussed how to identify if a paper was relevant...this is different
 - Now, you need to be able to say what they did/didn't do, how well they did it, what assumptions they made that you don't like, limitations, etc.

Project Goals

- Concise yet specific, notable yet achievable

Plan of Attack

- How do you think you will approach / achieve your project goals?
 - This must be reasonable, well-thought out, etc.

Deliverables

- Not just presentations and reports, but deliverables specific to your project

Schedule

- When do you hope to achieve goals, attain deliverables, etc.?

Budget

- Detailed breakdown of any costs associated with your project plan
 - Monetary costs: including hardware, software, services, ...
 - These all need to be approved before going forward.
 - Time: team efforts toward various aspects of the project
 - Resource costs: TD, faculty, external resources, ...

Challenges / Risks

- Try to do a fairly involved risk analysis of your project goals and plan
 - What could go wrong? Is there uncertainty? Are you relying on certain assumptions that you're not sure of?
 - What happens if things don't go as planned?
 - Have a Plan B, C, D, ...

Additional Info

- The SoW document should contain additional information about the team, plans for project output, etc.
- Complete details are available in the SoW template posted to Blackboard

SoW Presentation

- Locally at CMU, we'll also do a round of SoW presentations, tentatively scheduled for 9/23
- Presentations will be brief
 - Likely 1-3 slides, ~10 minutes
 - Presentation template to be posted very soon

Literature Review

- As part of the research project, I'm asking each team to also do a literature review / survey.
- This is separate from the SoW but should be done in parallel.
 - This is likely the foundation of some your goals, approach, etc.
 - Much deeper and more detailed than preliminary review in the SoW.
- Lit review is a separate document, due early Oct.

Lit Review Contents

- The “story” of your lit review will be similar to that of your SoW, but focusing on the broader problem space
 - Critical analysis / comparison of existing works in the field
 - Summary of what has been achieved
 - Summary of what has not been achieved
 - Identification of a few interesting open questions or problems of future interest
- Template / format to be specified.
